



Volunteer and Bond check Information

The SWSC is, for the majority, a volunteer run soccer club. That includes our Board, team managers, families that help run and execute our tournaments, field prep, Rec soccer program support, and the list goes on....and these are sometimes thankless hours of helping out where ever needed. So, thank you!! It can't be done without all of your support, both on and off the fields.

In the past 5 years we have more than doubled our numbers in soccer players, this accounts for more than 400 families, and growing. Which means a lot more help is needed in the continued growth and organization of our club in developing and supporting all of our kids in the game they love...SOCCER!!

The club asks that each family commit to 4 volunteer hours this upcoming 2016-2017 soccer season.

How the volunteer hours' work:

- 1.) 2 of these 4 hours are required at either of our club sponsored tournaments. The 19th Annual May Day Tournament or The 1st Annual SWSC College Showcase (Both to be held in the month of May 2017).***

These are the club's primary fundraisers. Believe it or not the May Day Tournament alone needs to fill at least 250 / 2 hour shifts the weekend of the tournament to run smoothly.

Along with the 2 required tournament hours, each family will be required to provide a \$125 bond check to their child's team manager by March 1st 2017. This bond check will be returned uncashed at the end of your 2 hour tournament volunteer shift. If at the end of our 2nd tournament the 2 tournament hours have not been fulfilled, we will deposit the check. (Bond check is directly attached to the 2 required tournament hour, only)

- 2.) There will be many opportunities that arise during the 2016-2017 soccer season to complete your remaining 2 volunteer hours. Reminders, updates and opportunities will be emailed throughout the year.***

Volunteer Commitment and Bond Check Agreement

In Registering my child our family agrees and commits to the below Volunteer Commitment and Bond Check Agreement:

“I agree that our family will provide 4 hours of volunteer effort supporting SWSC activities during the 2016-2017 Soccer Season.

“I agree to provide (to the Team Manager of my oldest child's SWSC team) a \$125.00 Volunteer Commitment Bond Check by March 1st, 2017. When I fulfill my tournament volunteer commitment, the Bond Check will be returned to me at the end of my committed shift of either the May Day Classic or the SWSC College Show Case.

If my family fails to complete its volunteer commitment, the \$125 bond will be cashed.

****If the Bond Check is not received by March 1st, 2017, no member of my family will be allowed to participate in any SWSC or team activity until appropriate arrangements have been made to complete this Volunteer Commitment.”***
