



Tournament Rules

- U10
 - Current CDYSL rules, 7v7 including the goalie
 - 25-minute games running clock,
 - No formal halftime break, referee may have teams switch sides if there is a significant reason
 - Non-competitive, no formal scoring or standings
 - Ball size - #4
- U12
 - Current CDYSL rules, 8v8 including the goalie
 - 2 - 16.5 minute halves
 - 2-minute halftime break, teams switch sides
 - Ball size - #4
- U14
 - Current CDYSL rules, 11v11 including the goalie
 - 2 – 19 minute halves
 - 2-minute halftime break, teams switch sides
 - Ball size - #5

*No single age divisions. Will accommodate based on information provided at registration

U12 & U14

Division with 8 teams, two 4-team Brackets (A and B)

Saturday

- Group Play Format
 - Each team in Bracket A plays every other team in Bracket A
 - Each team in Bracket B plays every other team in Bracket B
- Group Play Scoring
 - 3 points for a win
 - 1 point for a draw
 - 0 points for a loss

- Group Play Tie Breakers
 - Head-to-head play, if applicable
 - Highest goal differential (max. 3 goal differential per game)
 - Highest number of goals scored
 - Coin toss

Sunday

- Playoff Structure - 2 games (Championship and Consolation)
 - Championship
 - Semifinal: A1 v B1, B1 v A2
 - Championship: W v W, L v L
 - Consolation
 - Round 1: A3 v B4, B3 v A4
 - Round 2: W v W, L v L

If any Sunday game ends with a tie score, a winner will be determined by a penalty shootout

Standard rules: 5 players from each team, if still tied, “sudden death”

All participants in the shootout must be on the field at the end of the game

Division with 6 Teams

Every team will play every other team:

3 games Saturday

2 Games Sunday

Championship based points and tie breaker – Same as 8-team Divisions (*see above*)

Group play

Gavin Park Rules
